- Build a 'supporters' group across both bands (involve the JB parents).
- Re-launch website.
- Develop a separate plan for the Junior Band.

Medium Term - Retain and develop membership through engaging and challenging music, contests and concerts.

- Transition the demographic of some of our audience.
- Concert ideas:
 - Brassed Off show partner with theatrical group.
 - Re-union concert invite the many musicians featured on our band-room wall. Maybe Heritage Concert 2023
 - Joint Concert. Dancers, singers or theatrical.
 - Re-vamp Christmas Concert to optimize the opportunity (form a working group?)
 - Easter Show or other festival eg Vivid
 - Run our own Entertainment Contest Nothing since Ern Keller or Battle of the Bands

Longer Term – Secure the future

- Work out how to transition brass players from SYCB to Southern Brass.
- Transition from bass clef to treble clef for trombones, baritones and euphoniums.
- Work out how to retain woodwind players as they age.
- Investigate how to secure ongoing sponsorship.
